- Some children in EYFS, year one and six have attended school since 1st June but have not been taught the full curriculum. Some children have not been taught by their class teacher for this period.
- When key worker children attended school during lockdown, this was to provide childcare and not education.
- We have no attendance data to share with you for the whole of the academic year
- We have no test results to share as the government cancelled all testing, including the phonic screen check and KS1/KS1 SAT's
- Because of all of this we have no additional information to add to the reports that were written in the spring.

We know that this is not ideal, but we are all living in unusual times and appreciate your support and understanding.
