

## DATA Summary 2023

### Key Stage 2

Key Stage 2 SATs took place in May 2023. Although the data has yet to be validated the provisional results of our year 6 cohort are:

#### Attainment

This shows the percentage of our pupils that gained a standardised score of 100+ This is considered to be the age appropriate expectation.

| Subjects | School 2023 | National 2023 |

#### Standardised Score

The RAW score that each child attains in a test is converted into a standardised score in order to compare to other children nationally. Our schools average standardised scores in the tests are as follows:

#### School Progress

When the current year 6 cohort were in KS1 they were given a level for their SAT result. This level has been converted into points which are measured against the number of points achieved at year 6.
