- Kit lists are available on the Arthog website. A link is also on the Year 6 'Important Information' page and the Arthog page on the school's website. Please **send your child dressed in outdoor clothing** as we will be starting our activities as soon as we arrive at Arthog. There may be no time to get unpacked and changed.
- Pupils need to **bring a packed lunch** with them to eat as soon as we get to Arthog. Please note there will be no eating permitted on the coach.
- Pupils may bring up to £10 to spend in the gift shop.
- Photographs will be taken by staff whilst at Arthog; therefore, pupils should not bring their own camera.
