Dear Parents / Carers

It has been brought to our attention that a number of children from Year 4 have been using WhatsApp to send messages to each other. This has resulted in children creating group chats involving large numbers of children and, in some cases, children are sending messages that are abusive or inappropriate. This means that teachers are having to spend increasing amount of time resolving issues that have been caused by children using apps out of school that are not age appropriate. More worryingly, when using WhatsApp, strangers can be invited to the group - this could involve unknown teenagers and adults. Anyone that is invited to the group then has the telephone numbers of all the children within that group.

WhatsApp has an age restriction of 13. If you are allowing your child to use WhatsApp, it is crucial that you monitor what they are doing, the messages they are sending and who they are interacting with. Ideally, they should not be using it at all as it is a safeguarding risk.
