



# **Anti Smoking Policy**

**Introduction**

Smoking is a habit often learned in childhood that can cause illness in later life in those who persist in using tobacco. At Dothill Primary School we invest valuable resources in teaching our pupils about the hazards of smoking. We believe that children need to receive consistent messages about the importance of adopting a healthy lifestyle and we will provide a non-smoking environment in the school in which they can learn.

**General Principal**

This policy seeks to guarantee a healthy working and learning environment for all the school's users by eliminating the risk of passive smoking and promoting non-smoking as a positive, adult role-model.

**Restrictions on Smoking and the Use of e-Cigarettes**

Smoking is not permitted on any part of the school premises at any time.  
The use or charging of electronic cigarettes on site is not permitted.

**Visitors**

All visitors, contractors and deliverers are required to abide by the anti-smoking policy.

**Support for smokers**
