In reception we cover 7 areas of learning:

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Communication and language
- Physical Development
- Literacy (Reading and Writing)
- Maths (Number and Shape, space and measures)
- Understanding the world
- Expressive Arts and Design

Each half term we will be developing skills in all of these areas through different topics. We usually base our work around stories or information books. Our first topic is going to be Space. Throughout the year we will also be learning about Real Life Superheroes, Creepy Crawlies, Traditional Tales and any other topics which the children develop an interest in as we get to know each other. We have lots of fun getting Muddy in our outdoor Mud Kitchen area too so please make sure your child has wellies and waterproof clothing that they can keep in school, in a bag on their peg.

Reading is at the heart of all we do in school so teaching phonics is a key part of our day. We use a scheme called 'Read Write Inc.' at Dothill and you will be invited to an information meeting to help you understand the steps the children take to develop their reading skills. Our expectation is that children read at home 4 times per week. At the start of their Reception year, children might be reading picture books and talking about the story and characters with an adult. Listening to stories is also an important skill. Children will also be given a 'project' to work on each half term.

Routines

Children arrive at school at 8.45am Please bring a coat and a water bottle to school. Waterproof clothing and wellies for our outdoor area can be kept in school No extra bags please as we don't have lots of space in our cloakroom!

Children will stay with us until collection at 3.15pm from the same classroom door.
