Shoplifting drops following Christmas crackdown

> Officers from Wellington's Safer Neighbourhood Teams came together during the month of December to address some concern, held by local shops that they may be a target for thieves. Daily patrols were bolstered throughout the festive period with the support of two student officers from Malinsgate who provided a greater police presence.

> Officers also focused on a number of persistent shoplifters who had been targeting businesses and made several arrests. This resulted in the most serious receiving a banning order preventing them from entering shops in the area.

Autumn saw the launch of Wellington town centre Business Watch

Police and local businesses in Wellington town centre came together in November to launch the town's new Business Scheme. The scheme, which is based on the Neighbourhood Watch model, will see improvements made to the way businesses can report crimes, the sharing of live information about active shoplifters operating in the town centre and better communication with local officers.
