Key Stage 2 SATS took place in May 2016. The data is yet to be validated but these are the provisional results of our Year 6 cohort:

Attainment

This shows the percentage of our pupils that gained a standardised score of 100+. This is considered to be the age appropriate expectation.

Standardised Score

The RAW score that each child attains in a test is converted into a standardised scores to compare their score to other children nationally. Our schools average standardised scores in the tests is as follows:

School Progress

When this cohort were in Key Stage 1 they were given a level for their SAT result. This level has been converted into points which is measured against the number of points achieved at Year 6. This gives each child a progress measure.
