Frequently Asked Questions

Is it compulsory for my child to attend?

As the workshop takes place within school and is covering the content of the school curriculum, all children will take part in the workshop.

Why do I have to pay when it is a voluntary contribution?

Under the requirements of the Education Act 1966, we can only raise the cost of the experience by voluntary contributions but in order for the workshop to go ahead, we are dependent on everyone giving support.
