

Updates to Sandwich Order Form

This is a reminder to you that for the price of a school dinner (£2.30 from April 2019) you can order a school sandwich for your child. Order forms should be handed in by the Wednesday BEFORE the week that you are ordering for so that the kitchen can order the required food. As well as the sandwich, your child can choose three items from the sandwich bar - cake/biscuit, fruit/yogurt, cheese. They can also help themselves to salad from the salad cart.

If you are a regular consumer of our sandwiches then we have some updates to inform you of:

- The bread is now half/half; there is no longer a white/brown choice.
- Raisins are no longer offered as an extra item.
- The form now covers 8 weeks (4 on the front and 4 on the back).

Order forms are kept at the office - you can help yourself from the lobby, you don't have to ask. There is also a copy on the school website in the key information/school meals folder.

School Bank

We are delighted to tell you that the school bank, in partnership with HSBC bank, is open again in school for pupils in Years 3 to 6. The accounts will be opened by HSBC and maintained by the Telford branch. Children can pay money into their accounts via school and then this will be collected by a member of HSBC bank and deposited into your child's account each week. Children who already



have an account can continue to bring money in to pay into their account via school. An account needs to be opened with £10 but after that any amount can be paid in. Children who have opened an account enjoy bringing in birthday money, pocket money etc and seeing their savings grow. The school bank is open every Monday lunchtime in the school library, run by a group of year six pupils and supervised by a member of staff. If you are interested in opening an account for your child please ask them to come into the school bank and ask for some information to bring home to share with you.
