The time is nearly here for our annual residential to Arthog (3^{rd} - 7^{th} Feb '25). Please see below a few final details regarding arrangements and equipment:

- Kit lists are available on the Arthog website. A link is also on the Year 6 'Important
 Information' page and the Arthog page on the school's website. Please send your child
 dressed in outdoor clothing as we will be starting our activities as soon as we arrive
 at Arthog. There may be no time to get unpacked and changed.
- Pupils need to bring a packed lunch with them to eat as soon as we get to Arthog.
 Please note there will be no eating permitted on the coach.
- Pupils may bring up to £10 to spend in the gift shop.
- Photographs will be taken by staff whilst at Arthog; therefore, pupils should not bring their own camera.
- Medication if your child has medication that they need to take to Arthog, please complete a medication form and return to school by Thursday 30th January (if you have not already done so). Forms are available on the school website on the Year 6 'Important Information' page and the 'Arthog' page. Please bring the medication in a named bag on Friday 31st January and hand it directly to the class teacher.
- Please drop your child off at normal time on Monday 3rd February.
- Please keep baggage to a minimum in the past, some children have taken cases nearly
 as big as themselves and this can cause problems when loading onto and unloading from
 the minibus. Carrier bags should not be used to carry any separate items.
