How we Monitor Attendance

We monitor attendance daily and discuss any pupils of concern and those who are increasingly absent from school. We also monitor weekly by looking at the attendance percentage for each class.

We meet with our EWO (Educational Welfare Officer) every three weeks to discuss all pupils with attendance of 92% or below. During this meeting we plan how to offer support – this may be further monitoring, phone calls home, inviting parents for a meeting or issuing formal letters.

At each stage we will offer support to families and our aim is for your child to be in school.
