Dear Parents/Carers - year 2

As part of our UIFSM (universal infant free school meal) policy, the children will be provided with a packed lunch plus a drink. They will also be given a piece of fruit at break time. However, please supply them with a bottle of water (no glass bottles or cans please) to take with them to drink during the day. They will also require a small backpack bag to carry their lunch/drink.

Children should wear their normal school uniform and have sun cream applied before they leave for school (if applicable). They should bring with them a waterproof coat and a sun hat. Sensible footwear is also required as the grounds can have uneven surfaces, and it can be slippery at times. Lastly, please do not send the children with any money on the day of the trip.

In order to cover ticket and transport costs, a voluntary contribution of £15.00 would be appreciated for the trip. However, we must point out that if we do not receive adequate funding to cover costs, we will have to cancel this trip. Please see overleaf for further information.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is it compulsory for my child to attend?

We cannot force any child to attend any trip/visit but they are all educational visits, which enhance the curriculum and will benefit the work done in class. If they do not attend they will miss out on an important part of their learning experience.

Why do I have to pay when it is a voluntary contribution?

Under the requirements of the Education Act 1966, we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions but in order for the trip/visit to go ahead, we are dependent on everyone giving support.

What happens if people do not pay?

If the level of financial support is insufficient, the trip/visit will be cancelled.

What if I cannot afford for my child to attend?

If you are unable to make a contribution, please contact the school.

What will happen to my child if he/she does not attend?

If you do not wish for your child to go, he/she will be expected to attend school and will spend the day with another year group doing work as normal.

Do we get a refund if my child is absent on the day of the trip/visit?

The cost of the trip/visit has been worked out on the basis that all children will attend and therefore in the event of your child being absent on the visit date we will not be able to make refunds.
